





# Mission Gagillapur

### **Outline**

Mahila Abhivruddhi Society partnered with Hörmann Group to transform Gagillapur into a model village, under the Grama Jyothi scheme.

The Mission Gagillapur has visualised the following five strategic interventions, namely:

- Institutionalize community driven development process
- Poor and Marginalized Access Government Schemes and Programmes
- Improved Quality Education (Primary & Secondary)
- Placement Linked Skill Development & Career Guidance Support
- Address Development Gaps (Health, Hygiene, garbage disposal, ground water pollution, water scarcity etc.)

### Deliverables for Year 1

- Awareness created among the primary and secondary stakeholders on Mission Gagillapur.
- Built Social Capital through capacitating the institutions such as GP, VDC, SHG & SHG Federations and Youth Clubs.
- Established CMRC
- Built rapport with the companies
- Identified sources for mobilizing resources

## Progress Made (January to August)

#### 1. Institutionalize Community Driven Development Process:

- Rapport Building with CBOs, Govt officials, etc.
- Formation of Rajeev Gandhinagar Development Committee in 214 GGP.
- Distribution of pamphlets distributed contained information regarding the vision and goals of Mission Gagillapur.
- Training programs provided to 69 SHGs & 4 VOs on auditing & book keeping by trained CRPs from Kamareddy Cluster.
- Village Development Committee formed with 23 members, followed by five Functional Committees (Water and Road Safety Committee, Livelihoods & Youth, Sanitation & Greenery, Health & Education, Women Development) with 5 members each.
- Mothers' Committee was formed with 7 members.
- An exposure visit was conducted to Gangadevipally for the VDC members.
- Identified 2 CRPs in the village who is currently assisting in the Baseline Survey completion.
- CMRC building identified & rent agreement prepared & signed, starting from 22<sup>nd</sup> August.(Rent per month-10,000 INR)

## 2. Poor and Marginalized Sections' Access to Government Schemes & Programs:

- Facilitation of representation about the issue of non-payment for ISL construction to MPDO and got assurance for pending budget releases.
- Payment released & distributed on 5<sup>th</sup> August to 21 beneficiaries under SBM.
- A total of 31 wall writings were painted all over the village on key issues.
- Nahavidyalaya visited Gagillapur for a week and conducted health camp in 214 GGP, rally on Harithaharam in the main village, painted the tree guards, conducted cleanliness drive in Chaitanyanagar, spreading awareness about welfare schemes in Thanda, trained primary students in cultural activities for 15th august celebrations.







#### 3. Improved Quality Education

- Distribution of school bags, shoes & socks to all 3 primary government schools, and high school.
- Met the Headmaster and all the teachers to identify the requirements of the school.
- Celebrated 15<sup>th</sup> august in the primary & high school, and distributed prizes.
- Partnered with Vande Mataram Foundation to improve quality of education from Classes 6 to 10. MoU is yet to be signed.
- Conducting an exposure trip to Sri Ram Foundation's Education programme in Mewat, Haryana.
- One Vidya Volunteer identified with 9 years of experience and a B.Ed. degree.
- Facilitated in formation of School Management Committees in all government schools.
- Distributed notebooks (in all schools) and school benches in high school in Main Village by Hetero Pharmaceuticals. Requirement for more school benches were identified for other schools.







# 4. <u>Placement Linked skill development & Career</u> Guidance:

- About 150 youth enrolled and attended the selection process for skill development.
- ▶ 13 were placed at the National Academy of Construction in Madhapur (Hyderabad)
- 2 in Muthoot Finance
- 20 more people have been identified with existing skills set, and are being referred to surrounding companies by the JDM from DRDA.
- Skills required by women were identified, where 10 members were interested in making stabilizers, 5 in making detergent powder and 5 in incense sticks making.

## 5. Address Development Gaps through Community-Led Approach (Health, Hygiene, Garbage Disposal, Ground Water Pollution, Garbage Disposal, Water Scarcity):

- A refresher orientation was conducted for AWW and ANM on health practices & issues among women.
- Reviving RO Water Plant at Church GGP.
- Health camps were conducted with Mallareddy Hospital (with Gyneacologists-2, General Physcian-1, Dentist-, 4 Nurses and 3 Public relation officers)
- Facilitated the construction of water sump cum harvesting structure and repair near the RO plant.
- 4 defunct bore wells have been identified.
- Swacch GGP was conducted. One park was cleaned, garbage dumps were shifted to dumping grounds.
- Harithaharam was conducted in Main Village. (Planted 6000 saplings)
- The Foundation stone for a Primary Health centre was laid by Granules Company in the village (for 25 lakhs).
- World Breast feeding week campaign was held in Anganwadi centre.
- Requirements in the anganwadi centre were identified.
- Dental health camp held for primary & high school students, initiated by Gram Panchayat with Mallareddy Hospital.
- Deworming camp held by government for primary school students & high school students.











### 6. Project Coordination & Administration:

- Placement of Project Officer in GGP & Project Manager
- MoU was signed on 4<sup>th</sup> May
- Baseline survey is being conducted, only Main Village is left.
- Media coverage: Mission Gagillapur was featured in Sakshi on 21st May.
- A letter to District Collector was written for their support in the project.
- Lorenz & Martin Hoermann visited Gagillapur.
- Name board installed in Main Village GGP.





## Challenges faced...

- Operational issues of RO Water Plant
- Illegal land rights in 214
- Less community participation
- Lack of support from Gram Panchayat
- Proximity issues within the village from one habitation to another
- Community expectations are more inclined towards infrastructural activities (such as drinking water, drainages & roads)
