Peyyalapalem Model Village

Duration – October, 2016

1. Human Resource development

VDC meeting: The regular VDC meeting date is fixed as 15th of every month and accordingly, we have conducted VDC meeting on 15th Morning at 8 am. Total 15 members out of the total of 27 members of VDC representatives attended the meeting, additionally, 4 members and MAS Staff Mr B.Venkatesulu, Project Manager and Mr Bhaskara Rao, Project Officer attended the meeting.

VDC members Exposure Visit (27th & 28th October, 2016): The VDC members, women group members and youth of peyyalapalem, in total 34 members and MAS Staff Mr B.Venkatesulu, Ms.Sujata, Ms.Madhuwanthi and Mr Bhaskara Rao went to the 2 Smart Villages of East Godavari District for the exposure visit on model villages on 27 & 28th October 2016. We visited Burugupudi Village and G.Medapadu Village.

After introduction of everyone with the Burugupudi sarpanch Sri, Surya Chandra Rao, we proceeded with a transact walk in the village and analysed and understood the development activities in the village. The Village has the following attractive development activities:

750 IHHLs construction, Each household has one compost tanks constructed, 850 Soak pits construction, Panchayat office has one room specially for pensions distribution and a shed for the people waiting in the panchayat office with flexes of all the Govt. schemes and program, Plantation in the Panchayati places, Wall writings in the whole village, Kitchen garden developed in school primises, ICDS building construction and special food supply to pregnant womens, SWM(Chetta

nundi sampada tayari Kendram established)Cement Roads construction (50%NREG funds,25%MP funds,25%people contribution). After the transact walk and discussion, an interacting session with the sarpanch happed with all the members on various issues and activities in the village.

On 28th October, we visited another village G.Medapadu, this village also had SWM and a ban on plastic. The cleanliness and greenery was well maintained by the villages.

The exposure visit proved to be very effective and useful for the Peyyalapalem peoples for a change in their attitude. They seem to discuss the issues of their villages and solutions to solve those issues.

The next plan of action will include some important learning from this exposure visit in consultation with the VDC. People have expressed thanks to APMAS and Aurobindo for giving them the opportunity to visit these Model Villages.



2. Safe drinking water facility

RO Plant: The RO plant is functioning effectively in the reporting period. In continuation of the sale and recharge of the ATW Cards, additional 63 cards were recharged. From the total sale of 148 cards, 63 card's recharge was done from 1st October to 31st October.

3. Health and Sanitation improvement

SRP from School education, Head Master and APMAS staff, Bhaskar have conducted orientation programme for school children on ODF and introduced good habits and consequences of open defecation on health.



4. Education

Primary School: The Primary school was regularly visited by MAS staff. We interacted with the teachers and discussed regarding International teacher's day. Mandal Education Officer participated in the event and felicitated to MEO and School HM by SMC and Village elders on the occasion of the teacher's day.



Gandhi Jayanthi: On 2nd October, the celebration of Gandhi Jayanthi was organised in the school premises and Grama Panchayat office. We have conducted rally with School childrens, Sarpanch, youth and VDC members and conduct a gramasabha meeting with Sarpanch and panchayat secretary.



Increase in the enrolment: 2 more Children were enrolled in the school. The Head Master and MAS staff distributed books and uniform to new children. Our Education Volunteer continue teaching to students in English medium.



5. Other Development Activities:

16 Wall writing image paintings have completed in the School compound wall for Villagers behaviour change on ODF.



6. Met the Andhra Bank Manager and discussed about VDC Bank Account opening issues, they explained the account opening procedure and gave account opening form. In November 1st week, the bank account will be opened.

Civil Works: 150 CC poles are being made in the Village for fencing in the Public places.



Our staff had given support for the Aurobindo's activities at Dr.Ramachandra Reddy Hospital at Nellore.
