1. Human Resource development

VDC Meeting: The monthly VDC meeting was conducted on 10th November and recorded attendance of 21/27 VDC members. The meeting was attended by Sri P.Gopinadh Reddy from Aurobindo, Mr A.Kumaraswamy and Mr R.Bhaskar from MAS, Adarsa mitra volunteers apart from the VDC members.

After discussing the minutes of last meeting, the agenda of this meeting was discussed:

- Progress of the 144 IHHLs construction
- Proposal for Nadep compost tanks construction for every household was submit to MPDO,Kodavaluru,
- Cement Roads construction (50%NREG funds \$ 50% Aurobindo share)
- Tree plantation
- Civil works estimations
- Fencing of the identified GP Places
- Waste Management activities
- After the meeting, visited the GP places and look for the options to get the places cleaned.

<u>Meeting with the village youth</u>: The meeting was conducted on 18th November and was attended by 18 members along with MAS Staff, Mr R.Bhaskar and Adarsa mitra.

Following agenda was discussed in the meeting apart from the Last meeting minutes

- 1) Discussion on the development activities in the village till now, after Aurobindo-MAS intervention.
- 2) 5k Run participation. 3) Games to be conducted on Sankranthi festival time. 3) Proposal to get a Cricket kit from the model village project b the youth. 4) Tree plantation 5) Fencing to GP Places 7) SWM activity, etc. After the meeting, all the 18 youth members participated in 5K run Nellore. We used our model village Banner and public awareness slogans in the event.







SHG Meeting: During the reporting period, 2 SHGs' (Sai Baba, Sri Vishnu) books of accounts were reviewed and audited. All the SHG leaders interacted and planed a general body meeting to be conducted in the 2nd week of December.





<u>Identification of public places</u>: In the Main village, 5 Gramapanchayat Places were identified. In the VDC meeting, it was decided to protect these public places for future development. In this regard, our project fixed 150 CC poles with barbed wire in the four identified public places (Poleramma temple, Ganuga place, Near Mahalaxmamma temple, Near G.Prabhakara Reddy house). Remaining one are disputed and asking for 4 days times for Sheds cleaning.







2. Safe drinking water facility

RO Plant: The RO plant is running successfully in the reporting period. Total 154 cards were sold till now and 189 recharges were done by 30th November. The general servicing of the water plant was done this month by Saranya Enterprises.

3. Health and Sanitation improvement

<u>IHHL Construction</u>: APMAS staff is regularly following up with the IHHL construction in the village. The mike announcements on the ODF village have started towards the behavioural change of the community on sanitation and health. APMAS Joint Director, Administration, Mr. A.Kumaraswamy visited the IHHLs and gave suggestion of whitewashing the newly constructed IHHLs.







4. Education

<u>Primary School:</u> The Primary school was regularly visited by MAS staff. We interacted with the teachers and discussed the performance of the children or any other requirements of the school. In the reporting period, school children visited a science fare at Gurukulapatasala, C.S. Puram which is near to Peyyalapalem. The Head Master and MAS staff facilitated the programme.







Other Activities for school improvement:

- Children's day was conducted in School on 14th November '16. School Management Committee (SMC), VDC, Grama Panchayat and ICDS representatives were present in the celebration. Our Adarsa Mitras (Vidya Volunteer and General volunteer) and MAS PO conducted some Games for the school children on this occasion.
- School toilets repair works were completed







5. Project Management

Mr A.Kumaraswamy, Civil Engineer & Joint Director, Admin has visited the village 3 days in this month and reviewed the progress, taken civil works measurements, IHHLs work progress and attended the VDC meeting.

6. Other Development Activities

School Children's rally was conducted in the village on "Badi Runam Teerchukundam" Government programme.
