Key Responsibilities:

1. Block Resource Centre (BRC) Development:

2. Community Resource Person (CRP-EP) Capacity Building:

- Assist CRP-EPs in identifying business opportunities, scaling existing businesses, and developing sound business plans.

- Monitor and evaluate the performance of CRP-EPs and provide them with ongoing support.

3. Training and Capacity Building:

- Develop and deliver training programs on leadership, community development, business management, and other relevant topics for various stakeholders, including CRP-EPs, community-based organizations, DRDA staff, BRC office bearers, and entrepreneurs.
- Organize exposure visits for trainees to gain practical learning experiences.
- Facilitate the participation of relevant training organizations in field-based activities.

4. Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning (MEL):

- Develop a performance evaluation framework using key performance indicators (KPIs) to track project progress.
- Monitor the monthly work of project staff through BRC meetings and Mandal staff reviews.
- Maintain accurate Management Information System (MIS) data and share it with APMAS headquarters, SERP, DRDA, and other relevant stakeholders.
